



## SHIMOGA INSTITUTE OF MEDICAL SCIENCES

(Autonomous Medical Institution, Government of Karnataka)

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TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF TENDER FOR SUPPLY OF DRUGS to Teaching Mc.Gann Hospital for the period from **Oct- 2016 to Sept- 2017** for which Tenders should be submitted in two cover system.

1. Notice is hereby given that tenders should be submitted in prescribed form for supply of Drugs as specified in the attached schedule, to the Teaching Mc.Gann Hospital during the period commencing from Oct- 2016 or such other date as may be specified and ending with Sept- 2017'.
2. Bid documents available are from 11/07/2016 to 08/09/2016. Last date for bid is submission: 08/09/2016 at 05.00 PM.
3. Technical bid will be opened at 11-30am on 13/09/2016.
4. Every tenderer must go through the terms and conditions of tender carefully and understand them before submitted the Tender. No excuse that the conditions have not been read or understood will be entertained later.
5. The schedule of Drugs are attached in the list and indicate only the approximate estimated requirements of the Teaching Mc.Gann Hospital. There is no guarantee the entire amount will be purchased.
6. (a) Original Manufacturers and Original Importers of Drugs only should quote their rates. In case the any company wants to Participate through their authorized distributor authorization letter from the manufacturer to supply Drugs to SIMS, Shimoga should be submitted.  
  
(b) Each drug should have a guaranty certificate from Govt. approved drugs testing agency.  
  
(c) In case of quality issues, the supplied drugs will be sent for analysis by us to a testing laboratory of our choice and the cost will be recovered from the supplier.  
  
(d) The strip and the package should clearly state the name of the manufacturer who has participated in the tender only. The appearance of names of other manufacturers is not permitted and may lead to rejection of item supplied.
7. Rate should be quoted including all taxes and delivery charges. Revision of rates will not be allowed after opening the tender.

8. Rate should be quoted as per our specification. The contract rates should include charges for door delivery of the goods to Shimoga institute of Medical Sciences, Shimoga & Teaching Mc.Gann Hospital.
9. The rates quoted should be only in Indian Currency. Tenders in any other currency are liable to be rejected.
- 10. No tenderer shall be allowed at any time and on any ground whatsoever, for any claim for revision or modification of the rate quoted by them during the contract period of one year from Oct- 2016 to Sept- 2017 and there after if extended.**
11. The prices quoted by the tenderer shall not, if any case, exceed the controlled price, if any, fixed by the Government at the time of the supply of the articles to the Institute. If the price quoted is found to be in excess of the controlled price permissible under the Hoarding and Profiteering Prevention Ordinance, 1943, as amended from time to time, the contractor will specifically mention this fact in his tender along with reasons for having quoted such a higher price. The purchaser at his discretion will in such cases exercise the right of revision the price at any stage so as to conform to the controlled price or the price permissible under the Hoarding and Profiteering ordinance. This discretion will be exercised without prejudice to any other action that may be taken against the Contractor.
- 12. EMD amount of Rs. 200000/- in through e-portal under following modes. 1. Credit card, 2. Direct debit, 3. NEFT & OTC.**
  - a) Each tender should be accompanied by a deposit of Earnest Money of Rs. 200000 deposits of Earnest Money should be in the form of Demand Draft drawn on any one of the Nationalized/RBI approved Bank payable at Shimoga payment of EMD by any other form/mode will lead to rejection of tender.
  - b) EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT SHOULD NOT BE CREDITED TO ANY SPECIFIED HEAD OF ACCOUNT. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT SHOULD BE MADE IN THE NAME OF THE DIRECTOR, SIMS, SHIMOGA.
  - c) No interest will be allowed in this Deposit. Tenders not accompanied by the Earnest Money Deposit in the form specified above will not be considered.
  - d) IF THE FIRMS(S) FAIL (S) TO SUPPLY TWO OR MORE ITEMS WITHIN THE STIPULATED PERIOD OF 30 DAYS DURING THE TENDER PERIOD, THE EMD OF THE FIRM (S) WILL BE FOREFITED. THE FIRM WILL ALSO BE BLACKLISTED FOR 3 YEARS TO TRADE WITH THIS INSTITUTE. DETAILS OF FIRMS BLACKLISTED BY THE INSTITUTE WILL BE PUT UP IN THE INSTITUTE WEBSITE.

- e) The tenderer shall deposit an amount equal to 5% of the aggregate value of the drugs likely to be procured during the tender period as Security Deposit. The quantities mentioned in the tender schedule may be increased or decreased at the discretion of the Director. Annual quantities for which Security Deposit has been made is in no case binding on the Director to order the full quantity.
13. Failure to execute the agreement within the contract period on the part of the successful tenderer or withdrawal of his tender after the intimation of acceptance of tender has been sent to him or failure to comply with the contract owing to any other reason will entail cancellation of his contract. The earnest Money Deposit paid by him along with his tender will be forfeited to the institution and he will also be liable for all damages sustained by the Director, by reason of such breach and ultimately paid by the Director for the items purchased at the current Market Rate. Such damages shall be assessed by the Director whose decision is final and the amount so assessed is recoverable. In the event of such amounts being insufficient, the balance may be recovered personally from the contractor from his properties.
14. The Security Deposit shall subject to the condition specified herein, be refunded to the tenderer within three month after the expiry of the contract but in the event of any dispute arising between the Institute and the Tenderer, the Director shall be entitled to deduct out of the deposits or the balance thereof until such dispute is determined, the amount of such damages, costs, charges and expenses as may be claimed. The same way also be deducted from any other amount which may be due, at any time from the institute to the tenderer.
15. Drugs supplied to the Institute should be of good quality and the decision of the Director in this regard is final and binding on the Tender. If the quality of drugs is not satisfactory and they do not meet the requirements such as proper maintenance of cold chain, the same will be rejected and the supplied items has to be removed from the Institute by the Tenderer or by the Contractor immediately at their own expenses after receipt of intimation. If the item is not removed within four weeks from the date of the intimation letter, the supplies will be destroyed. The drugs will not be returned to the firm.
16. The Director reserves the right to reject the tenders or to accept the tenders and the supply of all the items or of only one or more of the items tendered for, in a Tender without assigning any reason for doing so.
17. The Director will be at liberty to terminate, without assigning any reason the contract either wholly or in part on One Month's Notice. The Tenderer will not be entitled to any compensation whatsoever in respect of such termination. The contracts shall also be renewed for a further period beyond the contract time in cases where such renewal is necessary.
18. The contract will be awarded to the successful tenderer for the supply of Drugs for the specified period and the Tenderer shall supply on receipt of

- requisitions from the Director or some person authorized by the Director to do the same as and when necessary.
19. Tenders should be submitted only for the Drugs asked for. Substitutes/Equivalents should not be offered. In case the drug asked for is not available and if rate any of the item not quoted column should be left blank.
  20. The successful Tenderer may not sublet/outsourcing production of drugs quoted without the prior permission of the Director.
  21. If any of the drugs etc. which the tenderer has failed to supply, it will open to the Director or to any person authorized by him on his behalf to purchase the said articles and to recover from the Tenderer the difference, if any, between the price of the Drugs and the price or prices payable under the contract to the Tenderer. Or the amount of EMD will be forfeited.
    - a). If a Tenderer fails to supply in time the ordered quantity of drugs within 30 days from the date of issue of the order, the order will be cancelled and the alternate procurement action will be taken and the difference in the cost will be recovered by way of adjustment against the Tenderer's pending bills or from EMD/Security Deposit made by the party with the Institute.
    - b) Tenderers should be prepared to accept orders subject to the clause for forfeiture of EMD/Security Deposit in the event of default in supplies or failure to supply within the stipulated period.
  22. In case any difference of dispute arises in connection with this contract, all legal proceedings relation to the matter, shall be instituted in the court within whose jurisdiction of the purchasing officers voluntarily resides.
  23. **First supply of item should accompany with the manufacturing licence/Import licence mentioning the name of the item supplied. Otherwise item will be rejected.**
  24. Any attempt on the part of the Tenderers or their Agents to influence the department in their favor by personal canvassing with the officers concerned will disqualify them.
  25. SELECTION OF TENDERS WOULD VERY MUCH DEPEND UPON THE LOWEST NET RATE.
  26. Prices quoted should be inclusive of all charges like packing, forwarding and duties, cess etc. which are or may become payable by the contractor under existing or future laws or rules of the country or origin/supply of delivery during the course of execution of the contract. The sales tax certificate as in the specimen should be produced along with Tender.
  27. Special conditions, of any of the Tenderers of those attached with the Tenderers will not be applicable to the contract unless they are expressly accepted in writing by the purchaser.

## **SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

All Drugs should conform to the standard required. I.P denotes Indian Pharmacopoeia B.P. denotes British Pharmacopoeia, INF denotes Indian National Formulary. The drugs should also comply with the standards required under rule 124 of the Drugs Act 1945. Minimum content of active ingredients should not be less than the labeled amount at the time of delivery of drugs.

1. In case of Drugs with life:-
  - (a) Stock should be supplied to this Institute from the latest batch and such a stock should have a minimum life period of 18 Months. Depending upon the normal potency prescribed, supplies with a minimum life period of 1 year at the time of receipt will be accepted with an undertaking given by the firm.
  - (b) In the event of such drugs not being utilized within their life period, the firm should undertake to replace the unexpended stock by fresh stock without any extra cost.
  - (c) Firms should clearly mention the Brand name or trade name of the drugs, etc., offered by them in their tenders. The composition of the formulations wherever possible may be furnished.
2. The firm should furnish a copy of their latest manufacturing/Import License issued under Drugs Act with authenticated list of drugs approved under the license.
3. (a) Tenderer should have WHO/GMP Certification or schedule M certification for each of the drugs quoted & should enclose the same with the tender.
  - (b) **Only manufacturer with an annual turnover above 30 crores each in the last three years audited balance sheet will be permitted to participate. Necessary certification in proof of this should be provided. Relaxation of this clause will be given to life saving drugs which are marked (\*) in the list of drugs. Submission of false balance sheet will make the tenderer ineligible to complete in the tender.**
4. The contract shall remain in force from Oct- 2016 to Sept- 2017 and the period of contract may be extended if necessary at the discretion of the Director.
5. (a) ONLY THOSE COMPANIES REGULARLY MAINTAINING SUFFICIENT STOCK AND READY TO SUPPLY THE QUOTED DRUGS SHOULD PARTICIPATE. THE ENIRE SUPPLY SHOULD BE MADE WITHIN 30 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF ISSUE OF ORDER (25% must be supplied within 10 days).
  - (b) **Supplies made after the stipulated period may be accepted if required, with a penalty of difference in cost of the next highest firm. If inconvenience is caused to the Institute due to late supply, Director is authorized to purchase the drugs from next bidder or open marked depending on the urgency & the difference of amount will be levied on the tenderer.**

- (d) Packing slip containing full details about the contents like Quantity, Batch No., Expiry date etc. should be pasted on every parcel.
- (e) A far as possible supply should be made from single or minimum number of batches. Separate batches should be packed in separate pack. If tenderer is repeatedly supplying in multiple batches suitable penalty will be imposed on the firm.**
- (f) Ampoules should be supplied with aluminum files for breaking them. Each pack to contain 5 files.
6. Free offers by the Tenderer shall not be accepted. Tenderers desiring to offer free good/items may reduce their rates suitable while quoting.
7. The Tenderer will invariably inscribe in each supply as “SIMS SUPPLY NOT FOR SALE” along with Batch NO., Manufacturing Date & Expiry Date of Drugs. Otherwise item will be rejected. Delaying supply due to this reason will not be accepted. However 25% of the drugs which need to be supplied within 10 days will be accepted if it is inscribed “Governments supply. Not for sale”.
8. RATES QUOTED SHOULD BE ON DOOR DELIBERY BASIS. COOLIE CHARGES IF ANY WILL NOT BE BORNE BY THE INSTITUTE. COOLIES SHOULD BE BROUGHT BY THE TRANSPORT AGENCIES WHENEVER REQUIRED.
9. Strips, tablets & ampoules of different drugs should be visibly different in color, size and shape. If two or more drugs quoted by the firm in this tender look similar, the firm may not be selected, even if the price is lowest. Hence the firm are requested to make sure the tablets/capsules/ampoules don not physically resemble each other.
10. Quote only those items which correspond to the specifications prescribed in the tender with regard to composition, strength, packing, formulation and other aspect. However in the absence of firms quoting the exact specifications, the Director reserves the right to select an item that is closest to the specifications.
11. Delivery:-
- i. Delivery must be completed within 30 days from date of the supply order (25% of the total quantity of the order should be supplied within 10 days and the rest within 30days from the date of supply order).
  - ii. A penalty of Rs. 500/- per day will be imposed for delayed Supply. Supply is considered incomplete till all the items of a supply order are supplied.
  - iii. **All the companies who have participated in the technical bid they should produce the samples for within 08 days from the date of opening of Technical bid.**

## **General Conditions**

1. Manufacturers licence or authorization letter from the original manufacturer should be submitted
2. IT returns of this firms for the last 5 years should be submitted.
3. Vat registration of the firm should be submitted with latest VAT clearance certificate.
4. Sales tax registration of the firm should be submitted with latest sales tax clearance certificate.
5. Firm should have a valid drug licence issued by competent authorities.
6. Quoting firm should produce a solvency certificate from a Nationalized /RBI recognized bank in the name of Director, SIMS, Shimoga. Solvency amount should be equalent to the total amount quoted by the tenderer.
7. This tender is of two cover system. First cover is Technical bid and second cover is price bid. Only those who become eligible in the technical bid will be eligible for the price bid.
8. All photo copies should be attested by notary.
9. All the Prints in check list should be complied.
10. Tenderers are instructed to submit a soft copy of price list of drugs in XL format for easy computation.

## **Other Conditions relating to supply of drugs**

1. Each carton should contain only ONE drug belonging to one batch only and each drug should be packed separately. Supplies with two or more drugs packed in a single pack to save space will not be accepted.
2. Labeling on vials/ampoules/I.V. fluids and other items should be clear and legible. Labels should be well stuck to the container. If not, the supply may be rejected.
3. The name, designation, proper address, land line phone numbers. Cell numbers, fax numbers, email IDs of the contact person (s) as well as the local dealer/distributor should be clearly mentioned in a separate sheet. And any change of phone numbers should be notified.
4. Supplies should be marked to Director SIMS Shimoga and should be door delivered. Supplies sent on 'to-pay' basis will not be accepted. Coolie will be brought by the transport agencies whenever required.
5. All I.V. fluids & eye/ear drops unless otherwise indicated should be manufactured using FFS technology. The bottles should be well packed in

sturdy boxes to withstand tacking. If packing is not satisfactory and the cardboard boxes are flimsy, the supply will be rejected.

6. Proper maintenance of the cold chain during transport is essential. Packages received without proper cool packs and whose temperature is not within stipulated range will be rejected.
7. If the quality of the items (s) supplied found to be substandard and any written complaints received from the user department regarding the quality, and quantity item will be rejected, order will be placed with next lowest firm, no payment will be made even for the consumed quantity item will be rejected, order will be placed with next lowest firm, no payment will be made even for the consumed quantity and the firm will be black listed.
8. IN CASE OF POOR QUALITY OF ITEMS SUPPLIED, THE NAME OF THE FIRM AS WELL AS THE DETAILS OF QUALITY CONTROL FAILURE WILL BE DISPLAYED ON THE WEB PAGE OF THE INSTITUTE, AS WELL AS INTIMAITN WILL BE SENT TO CDCSCO, DCGI & WHO-SEARO.
9. ANY VIOLATION OF TENDER NORMS MAY LEAD TO BLACKLISTING OF THE FIRM BY THE INSTITUTE FOR 3 YEARS.
10. Payment will be made after completing the supply of all items in a single purchase order. Successful tenderer should be prepared for this and give an undertaking regarding this.
11. No conviction latter of the manufacturer should be submitted.
12. No conviction letter of the authorized agent should be submitted.
13. **All the authorized agents should submit the details in technical bid in the following format only.**

**Note1**

1. Listing of serial number of Drugs should follow the same serial order as in Tender.
2. Tenders should quote Nett rates. No discount/free/goods/additives will be accepted.
3. Rates should be according to unit asked for. specification & packing size of each product should be as per details given in the tender.
4. Plea of clerical error, typographic error etc. committed by the tenderer would not be accepted, unless intimated prior to opening of price bid.
5. No correspondence will be entertained after opening the price bid.
6. The rates quoted by the tenderers shall not in any case exceed the controlled price, if any fixed by Central/State government and Maximum Retail Price (MRP). In case a tenderer quotes a rate higher than the controlled rate, he will be rejected and prevented from participating in the tender for the next three years.
7. The rates quoted should be in Indian currency only. Tenders in any other currency are liable to be rejected.
8. If the rate for any item is not quoted, the price column should be left blank.
9. One supply order one time supply.
10. L1 firm should supply within 30 days
